



Dayle Kitch Memorial Scholarship Application

The *Dayle Kitch Memorial Scholarship* honors the memory of Iowan Dayle Kitch, a former Destination ImagiNation® participant. Dayle was a team member for 8 years. During that time she exhibited the Spirit of DI. No challenge, including her wheelchair, could prevent her from using her imagination or her creative problem solving and teamwork skills. While in college, Dayle continued to exhibit this “can do spirit” by serving as a Tournament Appraiser. Dayle died on May 29, 2007 and is missed by many, though her spirit lives on. The Spirit of DI Award is granted at tournaments in recognition of those who act as superior role models in the areas of spirit, sportsmanship, and volunteerism. Dayle Kitch was that role model for many of us. As a result, the Students for a Creative Iowa Board of Directors is offering this scholarship in Dayle's memory.

The *Dayle Kitch Memorial Scholarship* is available to Iowa high school seniors who have been involved in Destination ImagiNation® for at least two years. The scholarship is a one-year, non-renewable grant of \$500. The grant will be sent to the student’s post-secondary institution following verification of successful completion of the first semester at that institution.
