 2. An original essay on a subject of your choosing that will give us a glimpse of the real you. You may write about a personal experience or an issue that is of genuine interest to you. This piece may be expository, fictional, or poetic and should exemplify your style, creativity and abilities.
 3. Sometime in the future, a friend that you met at college is asked to give a speech in your honor entitled, "Fifty Years of Great Accomplishments." Put yourself in your friend's shoes. Write the speech he/she would present.
